## Preakness Day EPILOG

As is my custom, here is the recap of the 2024 Preakness Day card, a soggy affair to say the least.

### *Selections For Race 1*

The rains came and the dirt course was sloppy and turf course “good” to start. I put in several early P5 tickets and hoped that BOMBER LADDIE DANCE would do some damage. My Saturday workout begins at 10 am and all was good. Except, at the last minute, word came out that Race 1 was now OFF THE TURF. I quickly canceled my tickets and sat it out. IRISH HEARTBEAT won for fun and, even though the race was run on dirt, LADDIE DANCE got up for 3rd at 35-1. Love it.

This race stayed on the turf which was now listed as “soft.” PORQUEROLLES went off at 3-5 but folded. BOMBER ST. JOHNS looked home albeit at 5-1 but was overtaken by one of my runners that I thought were hoping the race came off the turf—DESVIO at a whopping 38-1.

It figures that the race I nailed on paper is one that I missed wagering on. No problems and it was great to see Brittany Russell run a pair but her husband Sheldon winning the race with my MOST LIKELY at 6-1. Brittany's **MAGIC EXPRESS** ran 2nd.

So much for calling **SWALL** a BOMBER. He went off at 3-1 and had the lead in the stretch but was run down by my VALUE PLAYER, **APPLE PICKER** for Ms. Russell.

This race came off the turf and I had handicapped it for turf. So all bets were off. Todd Beattie's **CONCEPTUALIZE** went wire to wire at 9-2.

Overall, I would say I was saving \$\$\$ by sitting out these early races. Ditto for the Chick Lang as my **MOST LIKELY** scored at 8-5. Guess who ran 2nd? YUP. It was my **HEADS UP #1** player—**CATS BY FIVE**.

I was hoping to beat 2nditis type **FLUFFY SOCKS**. Unfortunately, my two best bullets to beat her—**SWEET DANI** and **DANA'S BEAUTY**—both scratched off the program. I sat another one out and good thing because **FLUFFY SOCKS** had too much class for this depleted group and romped by 8 lengths at 3-5.

The James W. Murphy kicked off the Preakness Pick 5 and it was time to dive in. **TWIRLING POINT** scratched so I moved up **ABRUMAR** to the "A" TEAM. I was pretty certain that **FULMINEO** with blinkers on would be a handful. He was, and scored by daylight at 2-1. **CRYSTAL QUEST** ran 2nd for a chalky exacta.

My hope was that The Jim McKay Turf Sprint would provide some value in the Preakness Pick 5. So far it had been chalk chalk. I was looking for an upsetter because I thought the two top faves—**WITTY** and **BEER CAN MAN**—were vulnerable for different reasons. When I saw **GROOMS ALL BIZNESS** sitting around 9-1, I made him my win play and tied him up with my A and B TEAMERS. From his hedge slot, **GROOMS ALL BIZNESS** saved ground and rallied stoutly to beat **WITTY**, as that one ran better than I thought he would on soft turf. To my chagrin, my 9-1 win bet was a mirage. The computer wagering hub kicked in and bet this one down to 5-1 on the last click. It was tough enough beating the chalk storm and then you get deflated odds. Woof.

**FUNTASTIC AGAIN** and **EMMANUEL** scratched so **BEATBOX** moved up the “A” TEAM which now was a trio. Trainer Cherie DeVaux had won three stakes on Friday so why not another? But my hope was that **EONS** would run a big one for CRABCAKE connections. Arnoud Delacour had won the Murphy and would surely have this one ready off an easy prep. **EONS** was 6-1-2-2 last year and 4 for 7 at the race distance. He had raced well on OFF TURF courses so all systems were go. I played him heavy to hit the superfecta at 21-1.

If he didn’t do it, then surely one of my other two “A” TEAMERS would get home.

Nope. Boy, was this race result a puzzle. **BALNIKOV** a Phil D’Amato trainee with an 0’fer at 9f and subpar efforts on off turf was bet down to 5-1 and ran lights out with CRABCAKE longshot **CRABS N BEER (14-1)** running 2nd.

My Pick 5 was kaput. I tortured myself mentally about not using the winner on my “C” TEAM. But as you will soon read, it would’ve been a losing wager.

**EONS** didn’t lift a hoof. Mystifying but in any Pick 5 or Pick 6 there is a certain randomness that can kick in on one leg. I had no regrets about not using this guy. He simply didn’t figure on any of my metrics.

I hate it when I'm out of contention on a Pick 5 in the final leg of a TC jewel. It means that I will have to manufacture a wager and spend more bankroll \$\$\$.

In this Preakness, there was little value from any of my "A" TEAMERS. When in doubt, simply play the *Twilight Zone* exactas and trifectas.

**Ky Derby Superfecta:** (5) **Mystik Dan (5-2)** over ALL over ALL over (3) **Catching Freedom (6-1)**.

**La Derby Trifecta:** (3) **Catching Freedom (6-1)** over ALL over (8) **Tuscan Gold (8-1)**.

**Arkansas Derby Trifecta:** ALL over (7) **Just Steel (15-1)** over (5) **Mystik Dan (5-2)**.

**Smarty Jones Exacta:** (3) **Catching Freedom (6-1)** over (7) **Just Steel (15-1)**.

**Southwest Exacta:** (5) **Mystik Dan (5-2)** over (7) **Just Steel (15-1)**.

I was all set to bet **JUST STEEL** to win. He had run 2nd in the prep that produced the Ky Derby winner and he was second longest on the board. But then I glanced at my *Sire Ratings* and noted just average OFF DIRT ratings that were confirmed by two losing efforts on that sort of track. But then I remembered that his uncoupled stablemate **SEIZE THE GREY** was being bet down and had an A+ OFF DIRT rating thanks to sire Arrogate. Plus this guy was bred to run all day with Smart Strike being the damsire. I switched gears and bet **SEIZE THE GREY** to win and keyed in the exactas.

Bingo. Finally a breakthrough and a sizable cash. Yeah, it would've been a gusher if **JUST STEEL** hit the board with him but he simply didn't like the slop.
